

## **REMINDERS**

There have been some questions and issues brought up to the GAHOA Board that might need to be clarified and hopefully we can help.

1. Parking on Right Of Way (ROW) and Disposing of Debris or other Types of Material in the Drainage System or ROW. The ROWs are basically from your property line to the road while sometime this can be confusing. We encourage you to find your property pins so you know for sure. We provided a diagram to give you an idea, also if you go to the county tax accessors website if you look at the map you can see where the property lines run.



We understand that at times when people have company or you are doing yardwork, vehicles will be parked there. However, you are also responsible for any damage done to the ROW when those vehicles are parked there. It is strongly encouraged no vehicles should be parked there for long periods of time. One reason is due to safety issues, the other is wear and tear of the ROW. If there is damage the homeowner could be subject to repair costs.

2. Vehicles. Many of us have old vehicles that are no longer in use and are in plain sight making them look abandoned. This can become a property value issue and a health/safety issue. During this time of year it gets warm, and many creatures tend to look for places to hang out. These vehicles need to be properly stored or moved.

## Section 13:

Unauthorized Vehicles and Use:

No mobile home, modular home, manufactured home, trailer structure moved from another location or any structure of a temporary character shall be located or used on any lot at any time as residence either temporarily or permanently, or for any other purpose. Commercial vehicles, mobile homes, motor homes, campers, and boat trailers shall be stored and kept in a garaged facility or within a structure or storage shed specifically approved by the architectural Control Committee so as to conceal the same from public view. All Motor Vehicles owned or leased or used by any lot owner kept on any lot shall be currently licensed and maintained in proper operating condition so as not to be hazard as a result of noise, exhaust emissions or appearance. All motor vehicles including trail bikes, all-terrain vehicles and motorcycles shall be driven only upon pave streets and driveways of Green Acres. No commercial vehicles shall be parked on the streets of Green Acres and/ or kept on any lawn.

Overall, the Board asks that everyone keep their yards clean free of debris and trash so we can have a neighborhood we can be proud of and enjoy. *Please note no actions are to be taken on any property without the consent or vote of the Board.* If you are unsure about anything, please contact us and we will work as best as we can with you.
